

02 DP 101-Opening DP and Discuss Sertainty Agent Video Transcript

[00:00:01] This is **Data Protector 101**: Opening the **Data Protector** and Discussing the **Sertainty Agent**. Starting on the toolbar, click **Data Protector** and this window appears. This is the default look for the first time when you open the **Data Protector**. You'll see a series of icons with this big large grey space underneath which is the **Task Configuration** management window and you'll see that your device that you have the **Technology** on is showing up in this particular folder right here which is the first of a series of folders that sit underneath of it. And down here in the bottom left corner is a green indicator button saying that the **Agent** is running. The **Sertainty Agent** is the background technology that facilitates the **Task** execution for the **Data Protector**. **Tasks** can only execute if the **Agent** is running. So if the **Agent** is not running the **Task** will not execute. Currently as a default, the **Agent** is running. And over here we have the setting for starting the **Agent** set at **automatic** and it can be toggled to **manual** if you prefer, but we recommend keeping it **automatic**. At any time that you need to stop the **Agent**, you can simply click this button here. You'll see that over here on the left this does shift to a yellow indicator saying that the **Agent** is shutting down and that we need to wait. And when it is fully shutdown, it will shift to a red button and indicate that it is not running. When you are ready to start the **Agent** once again, come over here, click **Start Agent** and it will quickly turn back on.
